- B) Quizzes
- C) Special Articles or Sermons based on The General Epistles
- D) Materials copied by copier by the other students in the class and shared with you

3) **If you are absent** for a class, it is **your responsibility** to get class notes and assignments from another student and be ready for the following class.

4) **If you want the third hour credit**, then the requirements are as follows:

- A) Read and fill out the workbook portions of the Jensen books for:
 - 1) James
 - 2) I and II Peter
 - 3) Epistles of John and Jude
