1) **Read** *Acts* **20-28** and Conybeare & Howson *The Life and Epistles of St. Paul* Ch. XIX through Chapter XXVIII. Included epistles: **Romans**, **Philemon**, **Colossians**, **Ephesians**, **Philippians**, **I** & **II Timothy**, **Titus**, + [**Hebrews**].

- 2) The loose leaf notebook should contain at the end of the semester:
 - A) The notes you have taken in class
 - B) Special assignments
 - D) Quizzes
 - F) Special Articles or Sermons
 - G) Materials copied by copier by the other students in the class and shared with you

3) **Term Paper:** Each class member will submit a term paper concerning some aspect of St. Paul's Life and Ministry. The topic will be chosen with consultation of the instructor prior to mid term and will be submitted prior to the preparation of the paper.

4) We will endeavor to **cover one chapter of** *The Life & Epistles of St. Paul* **per week**. You will need to come to class having **read the assignment from the textbook and any associated Biblical passages as required reading**.

5) **If you are absent** for a class, it is **your responsibility** to get class notes and assignments from another student and be ready for the following class.

7) If you want the fourth hour credit, then the requirements are as follows:

A) **Study** the *Beacon Bible Commentary* on **Romans** and one of the above Epistles. **Manually sign a note** at the end of the semester stating that you have read the **entire portion of the** *Beacon Bible Commentary* for your selected Epistles and **write a one page report** on **each Epistle** stating interesting things you learned. This note and page reports will be handed in to the Dean of the college.
